Alcyone

A 600-foot long submerged mountain with schooling Hammerheads and Mantas with the possiblility of Sailfish or Marlin.

Big Dos Amigos

Rainbow Runners, Yellowtail Snapper, Bigeye Jacks, Lobster, and Hammerhead are often found between the pinnacle and arch.

Bird Island, Chatham Bay

A variety of marine life including, Frogfish, Lobsters, Morays, Whitetip Sharks, and Hammerheads.

Dirty Rock

A large island with Marbled Rays and Hammerheads.

Lone Stone

Schooling Marbled and Mobula Rays.

Manuelita A sheer wall with Whitetips, Marbled Rays, and Creoles.

Ubing Rock, Wafer Bay This 300-foot rock slope that attracts schooling Hammerheads.
