Join Blue Green Expeditions on our journey to Russia! Lake Baikal is the worlds deepest fresh water lake and home to the only fresh water seal on the planet, the Baikal seal. The seals are very shy so those with rebreathers or free diving may have more success seeing them underwater. We will spend at least two days of the trip looking for the elusive Baikal seal. No one has ever gotten a good image of a Lake Baikal seal so you may be the first! Lake Baikal is a giant crack in the tectonic plates of the Asian continent with deep vertical walls and amazing visibility. There are canyons, walls, shipwrecks, grottos and tunnels to explore in this magnificent place. The water is cold so you definitely want to bring your drysuit! Our journey will first start in Saint Petersburg where we link up with the first trip group and we will have four days of touring. Saint Petersburg is often called the "Venice of the North" with its many canals and historic buildings. We will explore museums, waterways and cathedrals amongst other things! We then travel to Moscow for three days exploring all the highlights of the city such as Red Square, Saint Basil's Cathedral, the Grand Palace and other historic sites. From there we then travel to Lake Baikal for six nights aboard a liveaboard fully equipped for divers including rebreathers. There is a maximum of 8 people for this trip. This is one unique trip that you do not want to miss!!
