You can see mantas in many places around the world but nowhere else boasts a population of giant mantas that literally seek out interaction with divers and snorkelers. The behavior these giant mantas exhibit is almost inexplicable.

These gentle giants, with a wingspan up to 20-feet, consistently approach divers for intimate eye-to-eye encounters. If you are able to be calm and still, you are almost sure to experience what we call, "manta love."



While mantas are the reason many divers voyage to Socorro, there are lots of other animals to see, such as schooling hammerheads, silky and other species of sharks, bottlenose dolphins that consistently hang out with divers, large schools of pelagic fish, and humpback whales!


