Join Blue Green Expeditions as we journey to Churchill, Manitoba in Northern Canada to swim with beluga whales and explore Canada's arctic tundra! Every summer when the ice breaks up, some 50,000 beluga whales move into Hudson Bay to feed, socialize and breed. There is no where else in the world where we can find such

consistently large numbers of belugas. In the mornings we will board zodiacs from Churchill and snorkel with pods of Beluga whales. Afternoons will be spent driving through the tundra looking for polar bears, caribou, foxes and other arctic species. Churchill is one of the few human settlements where polar bears can be seen in the wild and is known as the polar bear capital of the world! On nights with high solar activity, we will head out of town to view the world famous Aurora Borealis (Northern Lights).
