Guests also have the option of adding on a 3 night stay in Havana including transfers, luxury hotel accommodations, guided tours and some meals.

 - Expedition price is \$4399 USD per person
 - Add \$1599 USD per person for an optional 3 nights in Havana and tours
 - A non-refundable deposit of \$1500 USD per person is required to hold your spot
 - Optional Havana trip requires an additional \$500 USD per person non-refundable deposit
 - A second payment of \$1500 USD per person is due by April 1, 2022
 - The balance is due August 1, 2022
