Arrive Havana (HAV) anytime on November 13, 2026. Our departure is at 9:00am on Nov. 14 for the coach ride to Jucaro. Plan your return home from Havana no earlier than 4:00pm on Nov. 21. We can make hotel arrangements should you arrive early or stay longer.
