The Silver Bank is part of the much larger Sanctuary for the Marine Mammals of the Dominican Republic. This protected area encompasses nursery areas (the Navidad Bank and Samana Bay) for humpback whales that summer in the North Atlantic. It also includes the deeper waters between the banks. These are important migration routes for whales headed to other parts of the Caribbean. The Silver Bank is possibly the most exclusive whale watching destination in the world. Only three permits are issued. This limits the total number of guests to no more than 60 a week, around 600 in an entire season. The low numbers help protect the whales from excessive contact and ensure you a unique experience. This is a snorkeling only trip and is perfect for kids of all ages.

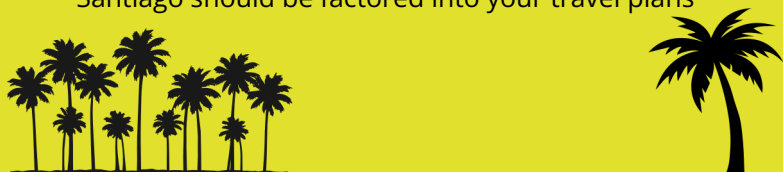

Arrive STI or POP anytime on Mar 20. Departure STI or POP no earlier than 12pm on Mar 27. Passengers must be in Cofresi on March 20 for a 5pm pickup. A 30 minute transfer from Puerto Plata or a 90 min transfer from Santiago should be factored into your travel plans



EXCLUSIONS

- Airfare to Dominican Republic- either STI or POP
- Nights at local hotel required due to flight and charter schedule. We will designate a host hotel once we have a better idea of participant flights.
- Soft drinks and alcoholic beverages while onboard Sea Hunter
- Travel Insurance including medical evacuation coverage and dive accident insurance for divers and snorkelers is required. Trip cancellation insurance is HIGHLY recommended.
- Transfers between airport and hotel, hotel and boat, boat and airport are additional and will be booked for the group once flights are arranged. Airport and tourist fees are subject to change without notice

This expedition supports The Seabirds Foundation, a female-led nonprofit advancing whale acoustics research in remote, data-scarce regions while expanding who participates in ocean science. Through expedition-based fieldwork, passive acoustic monitoring, and hands-on mentorship, they train citizen scientists to deploy hydrophones and document underwater sound, generating evidence of whale acoustic presence, communication habitats, and human-whale overlap. The Seabirds Foundation is cultivating emerging ocean leaders and working to create meaningful pathways into conservation. Proceeds from this voyage directly fund Seabirds scholarships, youth and education initiatives, and ongoing citizen science deployments, strengthening both the science and the leadership pipeline behind it.
